Background to the Gospel



Jesus continues using parables and analogies from agriculture and planting to reveal the Kingdom of God to the people. In today's Gospel, Jesus addresses the problem of good seed intermingled with bad weeds. The analogy speaks to the problem we encounter in our daily lives: how are we to handle the agents of evil? The first analogy of the good seed and weeds teaches that we are not to simply avoid bad people. It is our job, rather, to be good seed that survives and eventually overtakes them.

This is further emphasized when Jesus compares the Kingdom of God to the mustard seed. It is the smallest of seeds, but grows into a large and tall spread of mustard plants after its 90-day life cycle. The full manifestation of the Kingdom will take time, time which we must work in patiently. So long as we are still on this earth, God calls us to be the good seed, to be the mustard plants that evangelize the nations. Spread the Gospel boldly, that it may lead us to salvation.

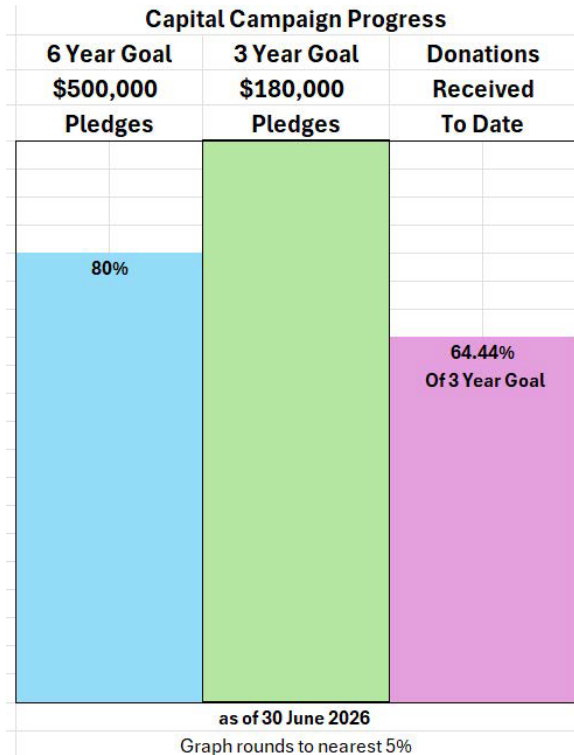
